Choose the fare that works for you...

30 DAY PASS

Valid for 30 calendar days from the date it is first used and is good for unlimited rides on any Valley Transit regular bus route. Please present your pass to the driver EACH time you board the bus. You will not need to request a transfer if your trip involves riding more than one route, but you should inform the driver if you need to connect to another route.

10-RIDE TICKETS

Valid for 10 rides on any Valley Transit route. Please present your 10-Ride Ticket to the bus driver when boarding. If your trip requires more than one route, request a free transfer when you present your 10-Ride Ticket. Your transfer will allow you to board another bus within 45 minutes of arriving at the transfer point.

DAYPASSES

If you'll be riding more than twice in one day, or using more than two buses for each trip, you may want to purchase a DayPass. The DayPass is only available for purchase from your bus driver and will allow unlimited rides on the day it is purchased.

SENIOR/DISABLED (S/D) PASSES

Senior/Disabled (S/D) passes are available for seniors age 65 and older and people with disabilities. When using a S/D pass, you must show one of the following identification cards to your bus driver EACH time you board the bus:

- Valley Transit Reduced Fare card
- Medicare card
- ADA certification card
