No bid will be opened unless the "Bidders Proof of Responsibility" for 2010 is filed in the office of the City Clerk not later than **August 4, 2010**. Forms are included in specifications, and are also available at the office of the City Clerk. Reference is made to Section 66.0901 Wisconsin Statutes.

Wage Rates: Pursuant to Section 66.0903 Wisconsin Statutes, the City of Appleton's rate of wage scale will be paid on this project, except as Section 66.0903 (4) or 0903 (5) may apply.

No bid shall be received unless accompanied by a certified check or a bid bond equal to five percent of the bid, payable to the City as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the proper contract and bond within 10 days from the date the lowest responsible bidder's bid is accepted. If the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set by the City, the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to accept any bid deemed for the best interests of the City and to waive any informalities in the bidding.
