Choose the fare that works for you...

To use Valley Transit II because of a **disability**, individuals must first be issued an ADA Certification Card. Details of how to achieve this ADA certification are listed in the Valley Transit II "Direct Transportation for People with Special Needs" brochure.

A qualifying disability, whether it be physical or cognitive, permanent or temporary, must prevent the use of the fixed route system for some or all trips. Whenever possible, the fixed route system should be used instead of Valley Transit II. For Travel Training assistance, please call 832-5800.

Senior residents, age 60+, living in Outagamie or Calumet County, do not need to apply for ADA Certification, but do need to show proof of age. Outagamie County residents should use an Outagamie Senior Certification. Calumet County residents may use a legal ID card, driver's license, passport, birth certificate, etc.

All riders on Valley Transit II must pay a fare (Exact fare or ticket required), except for a necessary care attendant. In addition to one

necessary care attendant, a certified rider may be accompanied by one non-certified person riding as a guest or companion. A non-certified guest or companion is required to pay a \$3.60 fare.

Door to door, door through door, and will-calls are premium service and require an additional charge above curb to curb. Passengers may need different fares for each part of their journey.

One-Way Fares:

Mon. - Sat., Basic	\$3.60
Mon. - Sat., Basic Will-Calls	\$3.60
Mon. - Sat., Premium	\$6.00
Mon. - Sat., Premium Will-Calls	\$6.00
Sunday Service	\$11.00

Sunday Fares:

Passengers can use a combination of tickets plus cash or cash only for Sunday Fares. Exact \$11.00 fare is required for each one-way trip.

Weekend service is only available to ADA Cardholders.
